Visit IGB – Research for the future of our freshwaters

The Leibniz-Institute of Freshwater Ecology and Inland Fisheries (IGB) is organising this year's SIL Conference. IGB is Germany's largest and one of the leading international research centres for freshwaters. Here, hydrologists, biogeochemists, physicists, microbiologists, evolutionary ecologists, fish ecologists and fisheries biologists from all over the world are working under one roof.

IGB has a historic location at Lake Müggelsee in Friedrichshagen. The Royal Prussian Institute of Inland Fisheries was founded there over 100 years ago. The main building is under monumental protection.

You will get to IGB by boat from Treptow Pier on an excursion steamer by the Stern und Kreis Schifffahrt Berlin. The boat trip takes you from the city centre via Köpenick to Lake Müggelsee in Friedrichshagen and lasts 2.00 hrs. From the Pier in Friedrichshagen, a bus shuttle will bring you to IGB.

Once you arrive at IGB, a small lunch snack (please indicate any food intolerances we may need to worry about), awaits you in the garden with a view on Lake Müggelsee. You will be welcomed with a short talk about the research at IGB. Afterwards you will visit the aquarium hall and learn important facts about the IGB species conservation project for the reintroduction of the sturgeon. You can see specimens of the European and Atlantic sturgeon. You will also visit the measuring station on Lake Müggelsee.

After a short coffee break, the bus shuttle will take you to the S-Bahn in Friedrichshagen. Departure is individual from the S-Bahn station Friedrichshagen back to the city.

Date: 11 August 2022

Duration: Start: 10.30 a.m. – Approximate departure time from IGB: 4.30 p.m.

Number of participants: 13 participants expected.

Meeting point: Hafen Treptow (Treptow Pier), Stern und Kreis Schiffahrt: 10.30 a.m (departure 11.00 a.m.). The Treptow Pier is right next to the Treptower Park S-Bahn station on the River Spree. Treptow Pier does not have an address (Latitude: 52.493376, Longitude: 13.4636243), but signs guide you from the S-Bahn to the Pier.

Physical abilities: no special requirements. A bus shuttle will be provided from the Pier in Friedrichshagen to the Institute. After the excursion, a bus shuttle will bring you from IGB to the S-Bahn Station Friedrichshagen.
