Among other institutes, we will visit buildings in which biologists such as Hans Spemann, Otto Meyerhof, Otto Warburg and Hans Krebs were active. The tour ends at a building where Fitz Haber, Max von Laue, Ernst Ruska and Albert Einstein made important contributions in the areas of chemistry and physics. It will be an easy walk. Bring something to drink.

Duration: 2 hours – A walking trip

Start: 10:00 am - 12:00 pm (approximate return time)

Number of participants: 15 - 40 participants max. In case we do not gather the minimum of 15 participants until June 15th, the tour will be cancelled.

Meeting point: 10:00am at the north entrance of the metro station U-Bhf Freie Universität. When you arrive at the metro station, you need to look for the exit to Landoltweg. This is the exit opposite the direction of travel coming from the city center.
