ACCESSIBILITY.

Messe Wien Exhibition & Congress Center is accessible on all levels to all guests with mobility or functional disabilities.

Public Transport

The two underground stations "Messe-Prater" and "Krieau" are both offering elevator access between platforms and street level in addition to escalators and stairs.

Parking

There are dedicated spaces along the main entrances for customers with a valid Parking Permit for People with Disabilities issued by a government authority, or equivalent international scheme. The car parks provide bays reserved for drivers with disabilities and have elevator access to all floors. There is a (taxi) drop-off point outside the foyers.

Doors, Lifts and Stairs

All entrance foyers are accessible at ground level.

All doors to the center and on-site offer wider openings and maneuvering clearances to accommodate different users and styles of movement.

We offer lift access to all levels, in addition to escalators and stairs.

Bathrooms for people with disabilities

Bathrooms for people with disabilities are located throughout the venue on every floor. All have an alarm pull cord system and are unisex. Accessible via the Euro-Key System.

Wheelchair access

All meeting spaces are wheelchair accessible.

Facilities for visitors with visual impairments

All foyers are equipped with tactile floor indicators.

All lifts have Braille buttons.

Guide and assistance dogs

Under the General Equal Treatment Act and the Federal Disability Act, guide dogs and assistance dogs are permitted to all forms of public transport, accommodation, and establishments that provide food.

The owner must show an ID, a vaccination carnet, and proper documentation to show the dog is a working dog.

The dog must be clearly marked as assistant dog.
