

ISER 2016 – POSTER PRESENTER GUIDELINES

Dear Colleague,

We would like to thank you for agreeing to present your poster during the XXII Biennial Meeting of the International Society for Eye Research.

The poster area will be situated on Level 43F in the Main Tower of the Keio Plaza Hotel. The size of your poster should not exceed 150cm in width and 90cm in height (**landscape format**). Fixing materials will be available in the Poster area. Posters should be printed on paper (no textile), landscape format. Posters printed on textile cannot be accepted. Please bring your printed poster with you, as printing possibilities in this format are not available in the hotel.

Text layout

Give a short and comprehensive review of the basic items of your study. Divide your text into clearly delineated paragraphs and sections such as Introduction or Aim, Materials and Methods, Result and Conclusions. Remember that it is easier to read a paragraph of six lines or less. Your poster text should be enlarged so that it can be read at a distance of about one meter.

Illustration layout

Drawings, diagrams and pictures are helpful and often necessary to illustrate results and conclusions. Make sure that your illustrations are easy to understand. Do not overload charts or drawings with information.

Poster mounting and presentation time

Your paper poster should be mounted and displayed at the following times:

Poster should be mounted:

7:00am – 8:00am (please check the notification email to verify the date)

Posters will be displayed:

8:00am – 7:00pm

Poster must be removed:

7:00pm – 8:00pm

Posters not removed after 8:00pm on the same day will be discarded. Posters and other material will not be sent to you after the conference.

Poster Sessions

All poster authors are kindly asked to be present at their poster to give a brief presentation and to answer questions by participants during the poster sessions.

Please note the following time schedule for the poster sessions:

Monday, September 26, and Tuesday, September 27, 5.30pm – 7.00pm (your poster session is on the day your poster is mounted)

Authors who agree to have their contact details made available to delegates are asked to include the information (e.g. e-mail address) on their posters.

Please note that you must make a mention on your poster disclosing your conflict(s) of interest, or the following sentence if applicable:

Disclosures: No financial relationships to disclose

All speakers and poster presenters need to **register** for the Meeting. Name badges and Meeting material should be picked up at the Registration Counter located in the lobby of level 4F of the Keio Plaza Hotel.
