

## Abstract Submission

### Guidelines

- Abstracts may be submitted for oral or poster presentation. The final choice of format will be made by the scientific program committee. Notification of format will be provided to the presenter when the program has been finalized.
- Early Career Researchers (ECR)\* may submit abstracts for oral or poster presentation.
- **Each participant is allowed to present only ONE abstract** but can be listed as co-authors on multiple abstracts.
- The abstract text must be added to the [provided template](#) and not exceed **2500 characters**, including acknowledgements. **The following items should NOT be added to the text: title of the abstract, authors' names, affiliations.** The title, authors and affiliations will be added automatically based on the information inserted in the submission platform.
- Tables and images can be included in the template. Please note that these may be resized to fit in the final publication.
- Abstracts submitted via fax will not be accepted.
- Submission of an abstract acknowledges your acceptance for the abstract to be published in the official Meeting publications.
- Abstracts must be submitted before **May 15, 2024, 23:59 CEST**
- Presenting authors of abstracts must be registered participants.
- Abstracts must be original and must not be or have been published or presented at any other meeting prior to the ISER Meeting.
- Abstracts must be received by the announced deadline. Abstracts received after the deadline will not be considered.
- The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission to the Secretariat. Please note that a copy of the submitted abstract will be sent to the respective co-author(s).
- The submitting author must declare if any conflict of interest exists, both in the submission and in the presentation's slides.

\* **Early Career Researchers** should refer to the ECR travel fellowship application section of the [website](#) for further information on the criteria for this financial support. Proof of ECR status should be uploaded during the abstract submission process.

## Abstract Preparation

Please note that abstracts may only be submitted in English.  
Before you begin, please prepare the following information:

1. Presenting author's contact details
  - Full name as in passport
  - Email address
  - Institution and Affiliation
  - Phone number
2. Author and co-authors' details
  - Full name as in passport
  - Authors' names must be in upper and lower case (Smith, J.).
  - Affiliation details: department, institution / hospital, city, state (if relevant), country
3. Abstract title - limited to **20 words in Title Case**
4. Abstract text – limited to **2500 characters**, including acknowledgements. Abstracts exceeding this limit will be rejected at submission.
5. Use only standard abbreviations. Place special or unusual abbreviations in parentheses after the full word appears the first time.
6. Use generic names of drugs. Express numbers as numerals.
7. Abstract Topic – abstracts must be allocated to a specific topic for the scientific program. You need to select the topic most suited to your abstract. [Here](#) you can find the full list of topics.
8. Tables – A maximum of one table of up to 10 rows x 10 columns can be included per abstract
9. Graphs and images are allowed.
10. Draft abstracts – The submission form allows you to store your abstract as a draft in order to make changes. Please note that abstracts must be SUBMITTED before the deadline (**May 15, 2024**) in order to be reviewed for inclusion in the scientific program. Abstracts in draft mode cannot be considered.

## **Rules for Submission**

The presenting author is expected to attend the Meeting and present the poster or oral presentation. The presenting author is required to ensure that all co-authors are aware of the content of the abstract before submission.

By submitting an abstract, the Abstract Submitter agrees to the following:

- 1.** I confirm that I previewed this abstract and that all information is correct. I accept that the content of this abstract cannot be modified or corrected after final submission and I am aware that it will be published exactly as submitted.
- 2.** Submission of the abstract constitutes my consent to publication (e.g. meeting website, programs, other promotions, etc.)
- 3.** The Abstract Submitter warrants and represents that he/she is the sole owner or has the rights of all the information and content ("Content") provided to the XXVI Biennial Meeting of the International Society for Eye Research and K.I.T. Group (Hereafter: "The Organizers"). The publication of the abstract does not infringe any third-party rights including, but not limited to, intellectual property rights. The Abstract Submitter grants the Organizers a royalty-free, perpetual, irrevocable nonexclusive license to use, reproduce, publish, translate, distribute, and display the content.
- 4.** The Organizers reserve the right to remove from any publication an abstract which does not comply with the above.
- 5.** I herewith confirm that the contact details saved with the abstract are those of the corresponding author, who will be notified about the status of the abstract. The corresponding author is responsible for informing the other authors about the status of the abstract.

A panel of scientific program organizers will review abstracts and results will be communicated to the corresponding submitting author.
