



GUIDELINES FOR POSTER PRESENTERS AT IUIS 2025

Thank you for presenting your poster at the **19th International Congress of Immunology - IUIS 2025 in Vienna, 17 August - 22 August 2025.**

The poster area is located in Hall X5, next to the Exhibition Area.

- You should bring a printed poster to the Congress venue. There will be no ePosters.
- Please bring your printed poster with you, as printing facilities for this format are not available at the Congress venue.
In urgent cases you can print onsite in Vienna at the following print shop:

- **Posters should be printed on paper in portrait format. The size of your poster should not exceed 95 cm in width and 128 cm in height.**
- Fixing materials will be available at the poster help desk. We cannot guarantee that posters printed on textile will adhere to the poster boards. Therefore, it is not recommended to print the poster on textile materials.
- You can find a template [here](#), or you can use a template of your choice.
- Note that the use of a sponsor's name, brand name or product name is not permitted in the scientific programme, in compliance with UEMS 2023/07 EACCME® criteria for the Accreditation of Live Educational Events.

TEXT AND ILLUSTRATION LAYOUT

- We recommend you give a short and comprehensive review of the basic items of your study. Divide your text into clearly delineated paragraphs and sections such as **Introduction, Aim(s), Methods, Results and Conclusions**. Remember that it is easier to read a paragraph of six lines or less. Your poster text should be read from about one meter.
- Drawings, diagrams and pictures are helpful and often necessary to illustrate results and conclusions. Make sure that your illustrations are easy to understand. Do not overload charts or drawings with information.
- You must add a mention on your poster disclosing your conflict(s) of interest, or the following sentence, if applicable: *Disclosures: No financial relationships to disclose.*
- Authors who wish to share their contact details with delegates can include the information (e.g. e-mail address) on their posters.



CODE OF CONDUCT

Only scientific content is allowed within your presentation.

Presenters are responsible for the content of their presentations, whether oral or written, and shall secure appropriate consent from collaborators and funders, as relevant, prior to any presentation at the IUIS Congress.

The presentation of research or data within sessions, posters or in other formal or informal engagements is the sole responsibility of the presenter. IUIS and K.I.T. Group are not responsible for the data, its accuracy or the way it was obtained.
