## POSTER GUIDELINES

The posters are divided by categories and each Poster Round will be displayed for **two days in the Poster Area**. In the two days there will be three poster viewing sessions during which the presenters are required to stand by their posters and answer questions from delegates.

### Poster measurements

The size of your poster should be **841mm × 1189mm = A0 format, portrait orientation**. Your poster number will be displayed at the top of your poster board.

### Poster board and mounting material

Poster authors are required to mount their **paper posters** in the designated poster mounting times. The Congress will supply the board, with a sign noting your poster number (at the top of your poster board). The number sign does NOT include the abstract title or listing of authors. Mounting material will be provided by Congress staff at the Poster Help Desk in the Poster Area. Posters should be printed on paper (no textile). Posters printed on textile cannot be accepted.

### Text layout

Give a short and comprehensive review of the basic items of your study. Divide your text into clearly delineated paragraphs and sections such as Introduction or Aim, Materials and Methods, Result and Conclusions. Remember that it is easier to read a paragraph of six lines or less. Your poster text should be enlarged so that it can be read at a distance of about one meter.

### Illustration layout

Drawings, diagrams and pictures are helpful and often necessary to illustrate results and conclusions. Make sure that your illustrations are easy to understand. Do not overload charts or drawings with information.

### ILTS Ethical Statement

The ILTS is an international society of transplant professionals and we support the international standards of informed, uncoerced consent of organ donors and prohibitions on trafficking of organ donors for profit.

### **Patient Consent for publication of individual patient data**

For all posters that include potentially identifiable personal details of patients (gender, age, illness, location) or images written informed consent for the publication of these must be obtained from the patient (or their parent or legal guardian). Please confirm in writing on the posters that the relevant consents have been collected.

## **Conflict of interest**

**All presenters are required to include a statement disclosing any conflict of interest\* related to your abstract.** This should be visible on your poster and state:

In relation to this presentation, I declare the following, real or perceived conflicts of interest:  
(description of the conflict of interest)

OR

In relation to this presentation, I declare that there are no conflicts of interest.

*\* A conflict of interest is any situation in which a speaker or immediate family members have interests, which may cause a conflict with the current presentation. Conflicts of interest do not preclude the delivery of the talk but should be explicitly declared. These may include financial interests (e.g. owning stocks of a related company, having received honoraria, consultancy fees), research interests (research support by grants or otherwise), organizational interests and gifts.*
