### **Guidelines for ePoster presenters**

Dear participant,

Your abstract has been selected as an **ePoster presentation** at the **36<sup>th</sup> Congress of the International Society of Limnology**.

All ePoster presentations will be available for viewing in electronic format onsite at the venue (Hotel Berlin, Berlin) and on the virtual congress platform both during the Congress and until at least 10 November 2022. You **do not need** to deliver your presentation at a certain time during the congress.

Instead, please prepare your ePoster presentation in advance. You can choose between two formats: 1) Video in Mp4 format including audio. 2) PDF format. Once you have prepared your file, please upload it on the online congress platform. If you chose a video format for your ePoster, please **strictly adhere to the time limit of 3 min**.

If you attend the congress in person, you will have the opportunity to present your ePoster for 3-5 min during a dedicated ePoster session on Monday evening.

We kindly ask you to **prepare your ePoster presentation** following the instructions below:

- 1. For an ePoster in PDF format**, please use a PDF file in a landscape format (Horizontal/ 16:9) and with a resolution of 1920x1080 pixels. The file size should not exceed 600 Mb.
- 2. For a video format, you can use PowerPoint:** Follow the link [here](#) to see an instruction video on how to record your ePoster with PowerPoint. In case you want to use another program to record your presentation, please deliver the video including audio in Mp4 format. The file size should not exceed in any case 600 Mb with a resolution of 1920x1080 pixels.
- 3. Upload your presentation to the online congress platform.**
